Background:

Violent Extremism in the UK is a real and severe threat and can involve the exploitation of vulnerable adults and children to involve them in extremist activity. On 1 July 2015, a new Prevent Duty came into effect which has required local authorities to have in place a clear framework with which to respond to safeguarding concerns for those individuals who are vulnerable to radicalisation





Channel Panel



Background:

Rochdale Borough Council has a Channel Panel policy and procedure which is based on the principles that a vulnerable individual is a unique person, vulnerable for unique reasons and needs an individualised safeguarding response. There is a duty to respond promptly and robustly to possible safeguarding concerns and there is a duty to share information with other agencies. It is a collaborative, integrated working process aimed at improving outcomes for individuals. The programme is a key element of the Prevent Strategy

Channel:

Channel is a multi-agency safeguarding approach to identify and provide support to individuals who are at risk of being drawn into terrorism by identifying individuals at risk, assessing the nature and extent of that risk and developing the most appropriate support plan for the individual. The adult has to give consent.

Channel will process the referral and make a decision about what action is needed. If there are urgent safeguarding concerns speak to your Safeguarding Lead who will contact a member of the Channel panel for an urgent response
